



2019 Decatur Farm to School Summer Internship Grant Program

Application

Decatur Farm to School invites eligible Decatur High School students to apply for the 2019 Decatur Farm to School Summer Internship Grant.

Program Summary

Internship grantees will work with local farmers, chefs, restaurant managers, and market managers as they learn what it takes to grow, sell, procure, and prepare fresh produce and local foods. In addition to training in Farm to School concepts, grantees will work at two locations during the summer to gain exposure to both the agricultural and consumer sides of Farm to Table.

Internship hosts include Farm Burger, Leon's Full Service, Love is Love Farm, Global Growers Network, Community Farmers Markets, and the Wylde Center.

Decatur Farm to School will:

- Give each grantee a \$500 stipend.
- Provide support from the Decatur Farm to School Manager throughout the summer.
- Provide training and internship opportunities as described.
- If desired, review any oral or written work the grantee creates for the program.
- Assist grantee in preparing a resume bullet point about their internship.

Grant Recipients will:

- Work with local farmers, chefs, and restaurant managers for a total of six (6) weeks for ten (10) hours per week, completing assigned tasks.
- After completion of the program, write an article and give a brief presentation reflecting on the internship experience.
- Participate in program training and debriefing.
- Get involved behind-the-scenes at some outstanding local businesses and have a great summer!

Eligibility: Program is open to students who will be sophomores, juniors, and seniors at DHS this fall.

DEADLINE: APPLICATIONS ARE DUE BY APRIL 29. RECIPIENTS WILL BE ANNOUNCED MAY 8.
